### **South West CDC and RSVP Singapore sign Memorandum of Understanding to appoint 3,500 RSVP volunteers to be part of SkillsFuture Advice (SFA) @ CDC network**

A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) will be signed between South West Community Development Council (CDC) and RSVP Singapore on **Friday 2 February 2018** at Suntec Singapore during the RSVP Singapore Volunteer Appreciation Day 2018 to appoint RSVP volunteers as SFA @ CDC Ambassadors.

2 RSVP Singapore Volunteer Appreciation Day is a major occasion where RSVP Singapore shows appreciation to its senior volunteers for their selfless services in the year. RSVP volunteers support programmes such as befriending persons with mental health issues, imparting IT knowledge to fellow seniors, providing guiding services to the public, and engaging young school children in character formation.

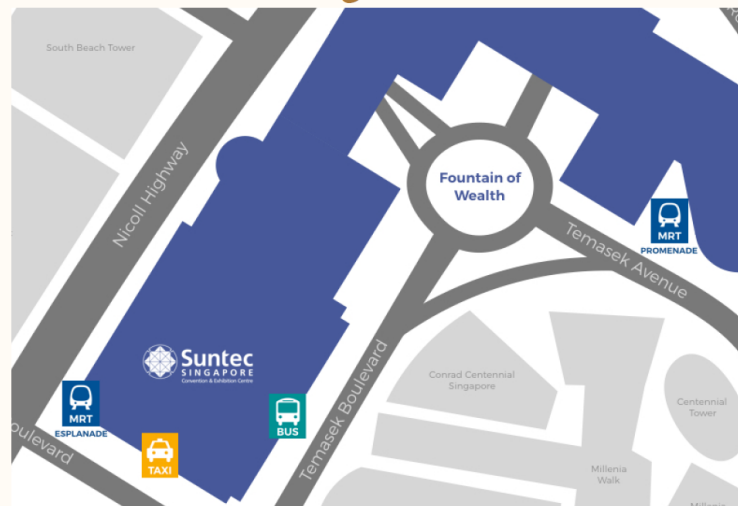
